Accepted Recycling Materials

- All items must be separated by type, and NOT in bags -

Paper - (Must be dry)

White, mixed paper, wrapping paper, junkmail, magazines and catalogs, paper sacks, phone books, newspaper, cardboard/paperboard

Plastic - (#1-7 Clean & Dry)

Soda pop and water bottles, milk or drink containers, food jars (mayonnaise, peanut butter, etc.) Laundry soap containers NO PLASTIC FILM (bags or wraps)

Glass - (Clean & Dry)

Clear, brown, blue, and green glass bottles and jars. Lids removed, lables are OK Metal - (Clean, Emptied, Detached)
Aluminum & steel cans, steel, iron
& aluminum scrap, dishwashers,
dryers, stoves, microwaves
FREON AT S WALNUT ONLY

Other Accepted Materials

Reusable - (Clean & in good, working condtition)

Small electronic items (microwaves, toaster ovens, radios, and fans), toys, housewares, books, magazines, kitchenware, tools, gardening supplies, etc...

Compostable - (Organic food waste only, with subscription) The list of accepted materials is long, but there are many important items that are not accepted. For a complete list, visit earthkeeperscompost.com/compostables/

Electrical - (Anything with a power cord, and WITHOUT a screen)

Materials Accepted at South Walnut ONLY

Hazardous Household Waste

Batteries, paint, gasoline, fertilizers, cleaners, pesticides, herbicides, oil, antifreeze, pool chemicals, over the counter and non-prescription medications (in the original container), fluorescent lamps Asbestos, radioactive materials or explosives (fireworks, ammunition, flares, black powder) are NOT ACCEPTED

Freon Appliances*

Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, and dehumidifiers

Electronics Screen Recycling

Anything with an electrical cord AND a screen*

Other Specialty Items

Styrofoam packing peanuts (boxed or bagged)

Books (paperback/hardcover) *Fee required to cover processing costs
